GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT PERFORMANCES

76th Annual Kentucky School Boards Association Conference



February 3rd – 5th, 2012 Galt House East, Louisville, Kentucky

Please use the following guidelines, adapted from those used by NSBA, as you complete the proposal form:

- Performing groups must represent a public school or group of public schools and have superintendent approval to represent their district.
- All students must be supervised by a representative of their school district at all times in the hotel. This includes, but is not limited to, hallways, all conference rooms, general ballroom, exhibit halls, and sleeping rooms/hallways.
- The KSBA annual conference is not the only event being held at the hotel during this time. Please keep space and noise limitations of the conference area in mind as you choose student presentations for consideration.
- Much of the conference format lends itself best to instrumental and/or vocal music that can be "background" music for conference activities such as meals and receptions.
- All submissions will be reviewed by a panel of planning committee members and KSBA staff.
- It is recommended that an audio and/or video audition tape be included. Tapes will not be returned unless requested by the district.
- Meal and lodging costs for students and district chaperones are the responsibility of the respective school boards. Limited funds are available to help offset transportation costs for student performers.
