# IS THERE A REQUIREMENT TO RECORD BOARD PROCEEDINGS?

While there is not a statutory requirement to audiotape or videotape board or council meetings, some agencies choose to do so to assist with recording of the minutes. If audio or videotapes of meetings are made at the direction of the district,

Note: The Kentucky Attorney General has said that if a public employee records a meeting: 1) <u>on his or her initiative</u> (NOT at direction of the agency or agency supervisors); 2) <u>at his or her own expense</u>; and 3) <u>personally retains the recording</u> instead of same being maintained by the agency, the resulting recording is personally owned and is not considered a "public record." - 06-ORD-195

# KRS 161.195 Requires Notice to Staff of Students with a Documented History of Staff Abuse/Weapons Violations

Any District employee assigned to work directly with, or who comes in contact with, a student with a documented history of physical abuse of a school employee or of carrying a concealed weapon on school property or at a school function, shall be notified in writing of the student's history by the Principal or designee, guidance counselor or other official who has knowledge of the student's behavior prior to the assignment or contact.
