FRYSC Facts

There are **857** FRYSCs statewide that serve over **1,200** schools.

Schools that have 20% or more students who are eligible for free and reduced-price lunch qualify for a FRYSC.

Once established, FRYSC services are available to all students, regardless of socioeconomic status.

Home Visits

GOOD NEWS - FRYSCs coordinated over **49,000 home visits** during the school closure (March-June 2020). The majority of these visits were likely to deliver food, household supplies and NTI packets.
